

## **EU Debate 2014 – Maastricht**

Monday, 28 April 2014

From 22 to 25 May 2014, European citizens will head to the polls to elect a new European Parliament. These elections are expected to be different, not least because several European parties will put forward their candidates for the presidency of the European Commission.

In this context, the Maastricht Centre for European Governance (Maastricht University, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences), with the support of the UM board, and in cooperation with the municipality of Maastricht and the European Youth Forum (EYF) has invited candidates for the Commission Presidency for a panel debate due to be held in Maastricht on the evening of Monday 28 April. This debate will be live-streamed all over Europe.
